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CITY OF HICKORY SPAY/NEUTER PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- 1) Participants must be residents of the City of Hickory.
- 2) Participants must have an individual annual income of \$40,000 or less, or a household income of \$45,000 or less.
- 3) The City of Hickory will pay designated veterinarians half of the cost of the spay/neuter of a pet. The participating veterinarian will charge \$140 for the spay of a dog and \$120 for the neuter of a dog (any size). **Cost to the participant is \$70 for the spay and \$60 for the neuter of a dog.** Participating veterinarian will charge \$115 for the spay of a cat and \$100 for the neuter of a cat. **Cost to the participant is \$57.50 for the spay of a cat and \$50.00 for the neuter of a cat.**
 - If necessary, dogs and cats will be given rabies and distemper combination vaccinations. Veterinarian charges for dog/cat vaccination is \$26. **Cost to participant is \$13.00.**
 - **Participants are responsible for paying the balance of the cost of spaying or neutering and vaccination of their animal at the time of the surgery.**
- 4) Through this program, there may be one pet spayed or neutered per household, per fiscal year (July 1 through June 30). This may be waived on a case by case basis.
- 5) Program participants will be responsible for making the necessary appointment with the veterinarian and transporting their animal to the veterinarian at the time of the appointment.
- 6) The animal should be six months or older.
